Year Long Programs

CEDAR PLAY SCHOOL - Ages 4-6

Cedar Play School is an enrichment class for the youngest members our learning community. Your child will have their own special space to enjoy play through creative storytelling, art projects and hands on, imaginative exploration. Each child has their own cubby and work basket for their materials. Mornings begin with movement, song and story, after which children feed their curiosity through sensory activities that connect with the season and the natural world through our garden and seasonal foods. Parents will be asked to help when we go on field trips or in other ways. Class size limited to ten.

Instructor: Jaime Van Doughty is a creative teacher with a deep love and appreciation for children and family life. She currently teaches at The Bridge School, leading classes in wilderness exploration, science and the arts. ON the PLATE & ON the PAGE – Ages 6-8

Students will expand their literacy skills through cooking-themed endeavors. Activities include learning about food through story books, songs, rhymes, and following recipes. Students practice descriptive writing by an qualating observations about ingredients/dishes, creative writing by conplains poems and stories about food, and procedural writing by recording it wanted recipes which will be compiled in a class cookbook. Of cont S in one will be hands-on cooking as well! Students may be asked the incompredients to share. (Allergies and dietary restrictions will be taken into account.) Class size limited to 6 students.

BRIDGE to BROADWAY - Ages 7-11

Students learn musical theater skills through rehearsing and performing in *Seussical Kids*, a Junior Broadway musical! Each day consists of practicing songs, dances and scenes from the musical and participating in games and activities to learn about an actor's tools – their voice, bodies and imaginations. The session culminates in 2 performances in mid-January (dates TBD). This workshop is for students interested in theater, as everyone is expected to participate; please discuss this with your child prior to enrolling. Parents are required to contribute three hours toward the final production.

This workshop is offered in collaboration with Hi-Liners Musical Theatre.

Instructors: Andrea Benson has directed productions of Lion King Kids, Willy Wonka Kids, and our annual Stone Soup play at The Bridge School and co-directed/taught classes at Hi-Liners Musical Theatre for Children. Her enthusiastic and innovative style is always popular with students of all ages.

Allison Gobat is a positive, resourceful teacher who has led theater, music and creative classes at The Bridge School and theater classes at Hi-Liners Musical Theatre. MUSIC & SONG WRITING - Ages 8-11

Students explore the science and poetry of sound and rhythm through the process of creating their own original pieces of music. Students study basic song structure: chorus, verse, bridge, and generate ideas for lyrical content as well as, tempo and melody. Instruments will be provided. No experience necessary. Younger students admitted with teacher permission.

Instructor: Anna Erickson teaches the Kokanee class at The Bridge School and loves doing hands-on work with kids. She is a musician and has a background in organic gardening – both of which she enjoys sharing with her students.

CREATIVE BUILDING - Ages 6-11

Students are introduced to and practice basic construction skills and use hand tools to create simple, fun projects. The focus is on safe and effective use of tools and building techniques as students earn "safe handling badges" as they progress. Beginning engineering and physics concepts are explored and time is taken to build confidence and knowledge that can be taken into projects at home or future workshops.

BEHIND the CURTAIN: Play Writing & Tech - AGES 8-11

Students learn about playwriting and how to relate scripts to aspects of technical theater. Students also have opportunities to design their own technical plans to support the play they are writing. These plans and plays will be brought to life in the Spring afternoon Friday Enrichment session.

CREATIVE BUILDING: Sets, Costumes, Action! - AGES 6-11

Students use basic construction skills to build individual and group projects. Some projects will be done in conjunction with the afternoon Play Production class and incorporate building costumes, props and/or set pieces. Students are trained on the safe and effective use of hand tools and building techniques and earn "safe handling badges" as they progress. Students will be divided into small groups based on their age and/or current proficiency with tool use.
