2020-2021 Refund Policy

Creative Enrichment tuition installments are non-refundable once paid, unless The Bridge School cancels class and does not offer remote instruction, in which case we will offer credit/refunds for cancelled classes. If WA State mandates a school closure, remote instruction will be offered for morning Creative Enrichment workshops and no credit/refunds will be given. This will look different than in-person classes, but is designed to continue the experience, community and learning for students. Credit/refunds WILL be given for canceled Cedar Play School and afternoon Creative Enrichment, as we will not offer remote instruction for these classes/workshops.

2020 FALL - SESSION 1

CEDAR PLAY SCHOOL

Ages 4-6*
Session 1

Cedar Play School is a once a week creative enrichment class for the youngest members of our learning community. Your child will have their own special space to enjoy play through story-telling, art projects and hands on, imaginative exploration. Children will explore sensory activities that connect with the season using natural materials and outdoor activity.

Class size limited to ten.

Instructor: Ali Arnote is an energetic teacher with experience teaching art and outdoor education to young students. In addition to teaching Cedar Play School, she leads Tinkergarten classes at local parks and heads outside to play with her family as much as possible!

FOLK & FAIRY TALES

Ages 6-8*

Using fairy tales from around the world as well as familiar ones, students will be inspired and invited to explore construction, writing, art, and science. Project-based activities will include comparing traditional stories, writing alternate endings, and constructing parts of the setting. For example, can the Three Little Pigs' houses withstand the forces of wind and rain erosion? We will find out!

MICROCOSMOS

Ages 8-10*

Inspired by childhood novels such as The Littles and The Borrowers, this hands-on class will focus on all things miniature! Activities could include shrinky-dinks, small-scale weaving, microscope work, diminutive dioramas, storytelling with pint-sized characters, baking and building in miniature and origami. Individual and collaborative projects will encourage imaginative free-play and projects will be guided by student interest and curiosity.

Ages 6-8*

Session 2 will cover two themes with a flexible time frame based on the enrolled students. The session will start with SCIENCE - where kids' natural curiosity will be encouraged through engaging, hands-on exploration of their questions about the world. Activities will be planned but leave plenty of room for student inquiries. Then the group will move into GAMES - where kids will play, deconstruct, and create board games, outdoor games, puzzles, and card games. Math and literacy skills will be strengthened as they design and play classic and novel games.

FRIDAY AFTERNOON MAKERSPACE - Ages 6-10*

The afternoon Creative Enrichment workshop option centers in an open studio makerspace, put together by Teacher Yon. Yon is the former owner of a makerspace studio in Burien that primarily used recycled materials. She continues to be passionate about sharing ideas, offering challenges and supporting students as they explore materials and make their own creations.

Students attending morning workshops will have a supervised lunch/recess period between workshops.
