
The Outdoor Education Program is a hands-on learning experience where nature is our classroom. We normalize outdoor learning environments while delivering hands-on science and social-emotional learning. Students increase their basic natural sciences knowledge of the outdoors such as identification of common plants/animals, knowledge of weather patterns, life cycles, ecosystems, and outdoor/wilderness safety. Our goal is to help children develop authentic connections to the natural world and feel comfortable outdoors in all seasons. Held at Seahurst Park in Burien, WA, students have access to marine and forest ecosystems to explore. Please send kids with all weather outdoor clothing. *If you are a returning family, please note our new start time of 9:30am!*

BRIDGE TO BROADWAY: *Could you Hug a Cactus?*

Mandatory Tech Rehearsals May 13, 14 & 15 from 1:15-4:30pm

Students learn musical theatre skills through rehearsing and performing a kids-length musical! Classes consist of rehearsing songs, dances and scenes from the musical and participating in games and activities to learn about an actor's tools – voice, body and imagination. The session culminates in two spring performances. This enrichment class is for students interested in performing on stage, as everyone is expected to participate; please discuss this with your child prior to enrolling.

This year's musical is *Could You Hug A Cactus?* based on a collection of whimsical poems by Phillip Van Wagoner, is a musical revue that follows a group of kids as they come together to create a show that's bursting with poems and creativity. One by one, they each share their imaginative creations, until a nervous performer panics and refuses to contribute a poem. Can the cast help him shed self-doubt and ignite a creative spark?



VISUAL ARTS EXPLORATION

Classes run January 10 - June 9* *No classes Feb 21, April 18, May 23*

Express yourself and explore new mediums! This class will focus on exploring various mediums for art-making, from print-making to animation and fiber arts. Students will emerge with new confidence in their identity as artists and new skills to use in realizing future creative visions. The class will culminate in a Bridge School Gallery show, where students will highlight the pieces of which they are most proud.

VISUAL ARTS EXPLORATION will run concurrently with another Enrichment class, Teacher TBD. Topics may include science experiments, outdoor learning, and movement/games.

TUITION INFORMATION

Core Program Enrolled Families: All students enrolled in Bridge Core Curriculum classes have one Friday AM Creative Enrichment session and all age-specific outdoor education included in tuition. Families may opt-in to the Friday afternoon session at tuition rates listed above. Creative Enrichment tuition installments are non-refundable, unless The Bridge School cancels class, in which case we will offer credit/refunds for canceled classes.

Enrollment Interest form due December 18 for Outdoor Education, January 6 for Creative Enrichment.

Homeschool Families: Creative Enrichment & Outdoor Education tuition installments are non-refundable, unless The Bridge School cancels class, in which case we will offer credit/refunds for canceled classes.

Tuition will be billed in a lump sum; installment plans available upon request. Once enrolled in a program, families are responsible for the entirety of the tuition fee whether paid in full or in installment.

Once you complete the [enrollment interest form](#), you will be contacted via email regarding availability in the programs you have selected, tuition payment procedure, and the registration process including immunization requirements.
